

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHETNOLE ROAD, LEIGH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along CHETNOLE ROAD, LEIGH between its junctions with Back Drove and Alton Mead Lane, a distance of approximately 260 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 7 September 2020 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 September 2020.

**This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out the installation of new connection.**

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: C93 - Melbury Road - Birch Lane - Church Street - High Street - Brister End - C45 - C93
