

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HIGHER TOTNELL ROAD, LEIGH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Higher Totnell Road, Leigh from its junction with Bailey Ridge, Leigh to its junction with Hermitage Lane, Hermitage (in both directions), a distance of approximately 900m. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation between 0930hrs - 1530hrs daily on 19th October 2020 and 20th October 2020 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 20th October 2020.

This Notice will enable enable BT safe access to carry out urgent works to restore customers out of service.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Sandy Lane - A352 - Leweston Road - Dyke Head - Bailey Ridge
