

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SOUTH STREET, LEIGH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along South Street, Leigh from the junction with Back Drove to a point approximately 70 metres to the north (in both directions). The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 13th September 2021 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 16th September 2021.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out urgent works to replace a pipe.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is indicated by the blue line on the map below.
