# LEIGH'S NEW VILLAGE HALL



## Built by the people of Leigh

A versatile meeting place for the village and the surrounding area

Set in the centre of the village, with ample parking and over 2 acres of landscaped grounds, Leigh's New Village Hall is an ideal venue for every type of function.

The Hall is built in traditional style, but to the latest standards for safety, insulation and fuel efficiency.

It is an outstanding addition to Dorset's public amenities.

## The Main Hall







The large Main Hall (15.2 x 8 metres) has a semi-sprung floor and enough space for sporting activities such as short mat bowls. The raised stage has its own side entrances and changing facilities.



The Main Hall can seat up to 150 seated, or 100 with tables.

#### The Kitchen







The fully equipped kitchen can cope with any event, big or small. It has a range cooker, industrial dishwasher and a large refrigerator.

#### The Committee Room

For smaller meetings, the Committee Room (7.5 x 4.2 Metres) accommodates 30 (closely seated) or 25 with tables.





As part of the Connecting Dorset Project it has full broadband and computer facilities, including scanning and printing.

### The Exhibition Area



The Exhibition Area at the side of the Hall provides an attractive setting for displays by artists and photographers.

# The Landscaped Grounds



The 2 acres of landscaped grounds are are in the picturesque heart of Leigh, and only a short walk from St Andrew's Church. They are being developed in association with the Dorset Wildlife Trust.

Attractive features include wild-flower meadows and traditional Dorset cider apple trees.

There are 72 off-road parking spaces, and a large overflow area capable of coping with many more visitors.

The Hall has plenty of space for outside events. Even if these are interrupted by unexpected showers, a glazed verandah at the side of the Hall provides an attractive shelter from the elements.
