- 4 Exhibit fees for all Classes are 50p – entries by children (16 and under) are free of charge.
- 5 Children can enter exhibits in ANY class. AGES should be displayed ONLY in Section 4, Children.
- 6 All Exhibits must be the property of the Exhibitor. All flowers, fruit and vegetables must be the produce of his or her own garden (except in Section 2, Floral Art).
- 7 No Exhibitor is allowed more than one prize in one Class.
- 8 All exhibitors are to supply necessary plates, dishes, vases etc. Presentation is very important, so take care in your choice of plates, vases etc.
- 9 No person is allowed in the Hall during the judging period, except those officially engaged.

Ingredients		Method			
<b>For the Sponge Mixture</b> 225g (8oz) Margarine 225g (8oz) Caster Sugar 225g (8oz) Self Raising Flour 4 Large Eggs 4 teaspoons of coffee dissolved in a little hot water. 150g (5 oz) Chopped Walnuts (save some for decoration)		1. Grease 2 x 8" 20cm tins and line bottom with greaseproof paper. 2. Preheat the oven to 180°C/fan 160°C/gas 4. 3. Cream sugar and margarine until light and fluffy. 4. Crack eggs into a jug and slowly add in the sugar and margarine. 5. Sift flour and add to the mixture and combine. 6. Dust the chopped walnuts with some flour, add to the mixture and combine. 7. Pour mixture into tins. Use scales to ensure equal amounts in each tin. 8. Bake for 25 mins. 9. Cool slightly then turn out onto a cooling rack removing greaseproof paper. 10. Place unsalted butter into mixer and mix until soft. 11. Add icing sugar and combine until smooth. 12. Add hot water to coffee powder to dissolve. Add to butter and icing sugar and combine. 13. Once cakes are cold, put half the buttercream on one cake. Place the other cake on top and cover with remaining buttercream. Spread out and decorate with the remaining walnuts.			
<b>Buttercream</b> 125g (4 1/2oz) Unsalted Butter 225g (8oz) Icing Sugar 4 teaspoons of coffee dissolved in a little hot water.
