Entry Cards will be ready to collect at the times above and are to be securely attached to the Exhibit or table beside it with blue tac, so they do not become separated from the Exhibit. The Hall must be cleared for judging at 10.30 am on the Show Day. Please do not remove your items before 4.30 pm on the Show Day.
- 3 Entry Forms are provided with this programme. Please complete (one for each exhibitor) and place in an envelope with the correct Entry Fees and deliver to the **Show Secretary**

- 4 Exhibit fees for all Classes are 50p entries by children (16 and under) are free of charge.
- 5 Children can enter exhibits in ANY class. AGES should be displayed ONLY in Section 4, Children.
- 6 All Exhibits must be the property of the Exhibitor. All flowers, fruit and vegetables must be the produce of his or her own garden (except in Section 2, Floral Art).
- 7 No Exhibitor is allowed more than one prize in one Class.
- **8** All exhibitors are to supply necessary plates, dishes, vases etc. Presentation is very important, so take care in your choice of plates, vases etc.
- 9 No person is allowed in the Hall during the judging period, except those officially engaged.
- **10** Prizes will be awarded, withheld, or reduced according to the merits of exhibits, and such awards will be at the discretion of the Judges.
- 11 Handicraft must be the Exhibitor's own work.
- **12** The Committee does not hold itself responsible for Exhibits.
- 13 All matters not met by the Rules will be decided by the Committee.
- 14 Exhibits must NOT HAVE WON A PRIZE at this Show before.
- **15** An engraved miniature will be given for any cup won outright for 3 consecutive years.


